

BA (Honors) Islamic Studies

Duration: Three years (6 Semesters)

Seats: 25 (Inclusive of seats reserved for NRI/ Sponsored candidates); additional seats are available for Foreign Nationals.

Eligibility: A candidate must have passed the Senior Secondary (12th Standard/ Intermediate) examination conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education, or any other examination recognized by Jamia Hamdard, securing at least **45%** marks in aggregate. Knowledge of Urdu is essential. Alternatively, he/she should have passed *Alim* from Madrasa Board or should have *Alimiyah* degree from Madrasas recognized by Jamia Hamdard, securing at least **45%** marks.

Note: Candidates applying for BA (Hons.) Islamic Studies are advised to read the list of Madrasas/ Boards /Institutions recognized by Jamia Hamdard as mentioned in General Information and Admission Guidelines 2017-18.

Selection procedure: Admission to BA (Hons) Islamic Studies will be made on the basis of merit determined by marks in the respective qualifying examination and/ or Interview.
