

Master of Occupational Therapy (MOT) – Paediatrics

Duration: Two Years (4 Semesters)

Seats: 06 in each discipline (Inclusive of seats reserved for NRI/ Sponsored candidates in each discipline). Additional Seats are available for Foreign Nationals.

Eligibility: A candidate must have:

- Bachelor of Occupational Therapy (BOT) from an institution recognized by Jamia Hamdard or University/Institute approved by UGC, securing at least 50% marks in the aggregate. The BOT course should be recognized by Delhi Council of Physiotherapy and Occupational therapy.
- Candidates who have obtained degree in BOT from distant mode are not eligible for Post Graduate courses in Occupational Therapy.
- Appeared in the Entrance Test conducted by Jamia Hamdard.

Selection Procedure: An Entrance Test will be conducted. The question paper will comprise of questions on basic sciences and occupational therapy subjects taught at BOT level.
