- The students from Iraq and Tibet will pay US \$ 2000 for BSc (Hons.) Nursing and US \$ 1000 for DGNM as an annual fee.
- For Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) sponsored candidates, the fee structure is applicable as per the fee structure of Jamia Hamdard Prospectus 2008-09. Details of the fee may be obtained from Foreign Students Advisor.

The fee of ICCR sponsored candidates would be fixed as per the list.

- Except for those Sponsored by ICCR, all other students belonging to SAARC countries and Tibetan refugees will pay annual course fee equivalent to fee charged from Indian students under SFS category. Where SFS fee is not available, the fee chargeable will be 50% of the course fee charged from foreign nationals from other than SAARC countries.
- ICCR sponsored students who belong to SAARC countries will be charged a per the fee structure mentioned for SAARC students in general and those ICCR sponsored students who belong to non SAARC nations will be charged with the same fee as mentioned in the Prospectus 2008-09
- The fee for supplementary examinations will be charged separately as per rules of the University.
- Failure to deposit the course fee in time will attract late fee of Rs. 30/- per day upto one month and 2000 per month or part there of beyond one month.
- In addition to annual fee there will be Transport charges per year to be paid by the students of all programme of Faculty of Nursing and other programmes wherever applicable.
- In addition to annual fee there will be refundable security deposit of Rs. 10,000/- in M.Sc. Clinical Research Programme.
- Annual fee in full will be charged for a course which is taught for six months in the last year of the course.

General Note:

- The Hostel fee shall be charged for the whole academic year. In case a candidate is allotted in the middle of academic year, the hostel charges shall be calculated at quarterly basis. Full Hostel charges shall be payable for full quarter or part thereof.

First Quarter: 1st July to 30th September;
Second Quarter: 1st October to 31st December
Third Quarter: 1st January to 31st March
Fourth Quarter: 1st April to 30th June

- A hostler will have to deposit an amount of **Rs. 10,000/-** as Hostel Security Money. The Security money will not be refunded if a student over stays in the hostel for more than a month after the last examination held for a particular course. Students can claim the hostel deposit within one year from the date of hostel vacation.
- Charges of single seated AC Room : Rs.120,000

- Allotment in the hostel will be for one academic year only. Allotment of Hostel for subsequent years shall be afresh and at rates as prevalent in those years.
- The above Annual Hostel Fees would be applicable for academic Session 2017-18.
- Hostellers will have to vacate the hostel at the end of the academic session (after annual/semester examinations). Seats in the hostel would be allotted afresh to the students in the month of July when the new academic session begins.
- Mechanical Laundry Facility is available and is mandatory for hostellers in the University. An allottee will have to deposit the annual Laundry charge for washing of clothes as per rules of the University along with Annual Hostel Fee. The charges will be decided by the University every year.
- Availing the Mess facility will be compulsory for the Hostellers of Jamia Hamdard Hostels. The mess charges will be as prevalent every year.
- Hostel bylaws will be applicable to the hostlers

GUIDELINES FOR WITHDRAWAL OF ADMISSION AND REFUND OF FEE FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2017-18

Following rules as notified by UGC will govern the refund of fee in case of withdrawal of admission.

- (i) Admission fee and Enrolment fee will not be refunded in seeking the withdrawal of admission.
- (ii) In case an admitted student does not join the university within 7 days of opening of the university, the university shall refund:
 - a. In case the student informs of his intention not to join the University at least 7 days before the start of the academic session, then 100% of the fees collected minus the processing charges of Rs.10,000 or the semester fee whichever is less. The same shall be refunded within 15 days of receipt of information from the student.
 - b) In case no such information is given by the student but the University is able to fill up the seat so vacated, then 100% of the fees collected minus the processing charges of Rs 10,000 or the semester fee whichever is less. The same shall be refunded within 15 days of request of refund from the student or the expiry of 30 days after opening of academic session, whichever is later.
 - c) In case no such information is given by the student and the University is not able to fill up the seat even by the end of 30 days after the opening of academic session, then 50% of the fees collected minus the processing charges of Rs 10000. The same shall be refunded within 15 days of request of refund from the student or the expiry of 30 days after opening of academic session, whichever is later.
- (iii) If a student joins the University, and then leaves it after 30 days of the opening of academic session then the entire fees collected shall be forfeited.

Fee Concession, Scholarships and Fellowships

1. Students' aid fund

JH has allocation in budget under Students' Aid Fund (SAF), which is meant for financial help of the needy students. Any student whose parents/guardians have annual income of less than Rs. 4.5 lakh is eligible for assistance from SAF, subject to his/her satisfactory performance in the previous examination and other conditions laid down by the University.

Fee concession for Indian students

1. Full free ship of Annual Tuition Fee up to 10% students in each course subject to relative merit. The criteria will be as under:
 - (i) The student must have secured 90% marks or above in the qualifying examination of the course
 - (ii) The student must have secured up to 80% marks in the written entrance test of the course.

2. 50% concession of Annual Tuition Fee up to 10% of the students in each course subject to merit-cum-means. The criteria will be as under:
 - (i) The student must have secured 80% marks or above in the qualifying examination of the course.
 - (ii) The student must have secured up to 75% marks in the written entrance test/Interview of the course.
 - (iii) The income of the parent of the student should not exceed Rs.2.00 Lakh per annum from all sources.

3. 25% concession of Annual Tuition Fee up to 10% of the students in each course subject to merit-cum-means. The criteria will be as under:
 - (i) The student must have secured 75% marks or above in the qualifying examination of the course.
 - (ii) The student must have secured upto 60% marks in the written entrance test/Interview of the course.
 - (iii) The income of the parent of the student must not exceed Rs.2.00 Lakh per annum from all sources.

GUIDELINES FOR SELECTING FOREIGN NATIONALS FOR GRANT OF PARTIAL FEE CONCESSION / FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM STUDENTS' AID FUND

There is a provision of discount in fee for the meritorious foreign national students from the Students' Aid Fund. The below mentioned criteria will be adopted:

1. The fee concession will be applicable from the 2nd year/ third semester (after passing first year / second semester) and onwards based on performance of results etc. in a particular course.
2. 25% discount in only annual Tuition fee of the concerned academic year may be provided to those foreign national students studying at Jamia Hamdard subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - (i) 75% class attendance in the concerned academic year
 - (ii) 75% Marks (in aggregate) in the concerned academic year (if semester system, then aggregate of both the semester exams)
 - (iii) Must have passed all the subjects of the concerned academic year in first attempt
 - (iv) Student must produce a certificate of good performance as evident by the academic record. The certificate should be certified by the concerned Head of the Department and forwarded through Dean of the School
3. 15% discount in only annual Tuition fee of the concerned academic year may be provided to those foreign national students studying at Jamia Hamdard subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - (i) 75% class attendance in the concerned academic year
 - (ii) 65% Marks (in aggregate) in the concerned academic year (if semester system, then aggregate of both the semester exams)
 - (iii) Must have passed all the subjects of the concerned academic year in first attempt
 - (iv) Student must produce a certificate of good performance as evident by the academic record. The certificate should be certified by the concerned Head of the Department and forwarded through Dean of the School.
